### **TITI Celebrates Silver Jubilee**



The silver Jubliee program was inaugurated by the Honorable Minister of Education Mr. Dhaniram Paudel. The Minister stated that the entire country is in the process of implementing the federalization system as per the new constitution. According to Minister Paudel, the education sector will be expanded and its quality system will be improved to meet CTEVT's vision "Skilling Nepal for People's Prosperity." According to the new structure, the technical education will be expanded in all election areas. However, the government and affiliated schools may face the challenge to manage technical human resource required in the new structure. To address this issue, TITI is the prime institution in developing required technical human resources. Minister Paudel advised TITI to make its vision according to the changing requirement of the country.

Minister Paudel believed, **TITI** will continue its services in producing human resources who are capable of working both at the national and international level thus helping Nepal to get international recognition.

During the program Minister Paudel also inaugurated the **SMARIKA**, a publication of Research and Development Department of **TITI**, published for the silver jubilee ceremony. Minister Paudel also inaugurated the stone sculpture **SMARAK** at the premises of **TITI**.

The Education Minister, Mr. Paudel distributed certificates of appreciation to different individuals who had contributed to **TITI** as Managerial Staff, Executive Directors, Directors and to the donor agency. Similarly, the staff of **TITI** who had provided their service to **TITI** for more than 15 years received life time service award from the minister. The students securing the highest marks in the Bachelor Degree in Technical Education affiliated to Kathmandu University were also awarded on the occasion.

## Address from Executive Director of TITI, Ms. Akim Shrestha.



The Executive Director of **TITI**, Ms. Akim Shrestha stated "From the time of its establishment **TITI** has been serving Nepal's technical and vocational sector by upgrading the standard of training as per the direction of CTEVT." According to her, the main aim of the institution is to upgrade the skill and knowledge of instructors and staffs working in different institutions and schools affiliated to CTEVT. She further added that, **TITI** provides its services to Government, Non-Government and International organizations in developing their human resources.

According to her, **TITI** has trained over 26 thousand instructors, managers, curriculum developers, community developers, researchers and other personals, and trained over 51 national and international trainees in Diploma in Technical Instruction program. In addition, 43 technical and vocational trainers have completed four-year Bachelors Degree in Technical Education, Kathmandu University.

Ms. Shrestha also briefed about the skill/concept card system of **TITI** in addition to various fields of case studies. According to her, this system will continue in the future as well. For internal capacity building, Ms. Shrestha said, **TITI** has participated in both national and international training and workshops and conducted different in-house capacity building for its staff by inviting both national and international experts. While concluding her remarks, Ms. Shrestha said, **TITI** has a vision to enhance the quality of its services and programs to international level and **TITI** is ready to re-structure itself to broaden its program and services according to the new federal structure of the country.


